

SOM/MTQIP COLLABORATION

OVERVIEW

- The Michigan Trauma Quality Improvement Program has been contracted to collect and sanitize data submitted by designated Level III Trauma Centers. MTQIP will compile and submit one aggregate data set to the State of Michigan.

PURPOSE

- Provide feedback reports to Level III Trauma Centers to measure performance and identify areas of improvement.
- When centers remain in a silo, data is not meaningful. A center with a CAUTI rate of 5% cannot know if the rate is significant unless it is compared to data from similar centers.

FAQS

- Q1: What is risk-adjustment?
- A1: Risk-adjustment accounts for the sickness of each center's patient group when comparing data. Please find the following video with more information about risk-adjustment [here](#).
- Q2: What infrastructure is needed to participate?
- A2: DI and CDM will install the MTQIP tab into your registry. This portal will be used for data submission. Centers using other trauma registry vendors please contact Jill at (734) 763-8229 to discuss.
- Q3: What data will centers submit to MTQIP?
- A3: NTDS data.

FAQS

- Q4: Will there be an on-site review related to data entry?
- A4: No, it is not a part of the current agreement.
- Q5: How often will data be submitted?
- A5: The first data submission deadline is February 2, 2018, but all centers are encouraged to submit ASAP. This will include data from January 1, 2016 – present. The full data submission schedule is available [here](#).
- Q6: When will a benchmarking report be available?
- A6: As soon as possible. This depends on how soon participants submit.

FAQS

- Q6: Will there be a cost associated with participating?
- A6: No.
- Q7: Will the SOM or MTQIP provide extra resources/funding to participate in this project?
- A7: The data submitted to MTQIP is standard data that is being collected by the centers. No other resources or funding will be necessary.
